### HOLIDAYS IN TERM TIME

As many of you will be aware, after the well-publicised court case regarding issuing fines for unauthorised holidays in term time, Local Authorities have now been given the go-ahead to begin to issue these fines again.

We are obliged to make parents aware that this is the case, and that from September 2017 onwards, holidays taken in term time, which do not meet criteria, will be unauthorised and a Fixed Penalty Notice may be issued by the Local Authority.

This fine currently stands at £60 per child, per adult in the household.

### SUMMER CLUBS

Due to relatively low numbers in the Easter Holiday Club, and the club therefore not breaking even financially, a letter is going to be sent home to gather information about potential take-up for the Summer Clubs we have planned.

Based on parental feedback we are proposing to offer 2 finish times over summer: 3:30pm and 5:30pm, in the hope that this will make the club a viable childcare option for more families.
