Y6 SATS RESULTS

Parents of pupils in Y6 will receive notification of how your child has done in their recent tests in July, when we have received official confirmation from the Department for Education. A letter outlining the results and a comparison will be sent home in an envelope with your child. Writing results are 'teacher assessed', as there is no longer a 'test' for writing.

Y2 SATS RESULTS

Parents of pupils in Y2 will also receive notification in July of how pupils have been assessed at the end of Year 2. A letter outlining the results and a comparison will be sent home in an envelope with your child. Results in Year 2 are 'teacher assessed', as they are not based solely on scores from the tests.

Exact dates these results will be released have not yet been shared by the Department for Education, but we will be working towards this date, when we receive it.
