### **Changes For The Autumn Term**

During the Autumn Term, we will cease using ParentPay and will fully utilise our School Hub Catering Portal for school lunch orders and payments. In summary, lunches can be ordered from home via School Hub and all payments will be made via School Hub Wallet. If a parent is eligible for a Free school meal (including Universal for Rec, YI & Y2), you will not have to do anything. Those who pay for a school meal will need to put credit on their wallet in order to order a meal. There will be a screen ticket machine in the dining area where the pupils will collect their ticket showing their chosen meal and hand to Catherine. Parent User Guides and details will be shared and on the website once we are set up and ready to move over to School Hub.

We will also move our communication from ParentPay to Arbor Communication. Again, once this is up and running (we will need to migrate and set up users etc) parents will be sent full details and a log in the register. We will keep you fully informed but wanted to let you know the plans in advance, which will make our processes more efficient and will be more parent / pupil-friendly.
