However, as you've likely noticed in your grocery shopping, overall food prices have risen significantly. To maintain our high-quality meals that meet government nutritional guidelines, our caterer must adjust their prices again. Effective in September, the price of a school meal will increase to £3.00. We appreciate your understanding.
