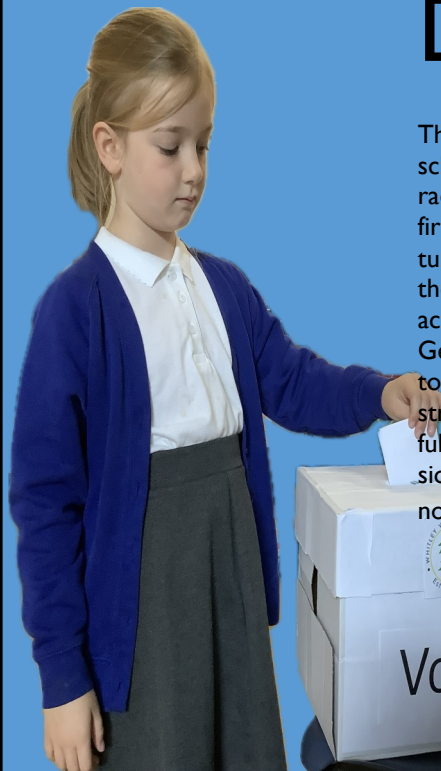

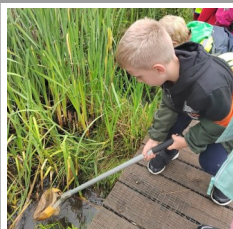
# Democracy In Action

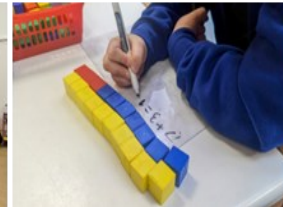
