#### Thursday 12th December at 2pm and 6pm



### Reminder

Cases of winter flu are increasing rapidly, prompting England's Chief Medical Officer, Professor Chris Whitty, to urge those eligible to get vaccinated. The latest data reveals that flu cases are particularly high among children aged 5 to 14, with 16.9% of tests returning positive results, up from 11.5% the previous week.
